## OFFICE ORDER

Sub: Institutes/Agency authorise for demarcation of High Tide Line/Low Tide Line in the Coastal Regulation Zone – regarding.

In continuation to our earlier letter of even number dated 29th December, 1999 on the above subject, National Centre for Sustainable Coastal Management (NCSCM), Chennai, has also been authorised by the Central Government for demarcating High Tide Line (HTL) and Low Tide Line (LTL) in Coastal Regulation Zone (CRZ).

 The coastal State government and the Union Territory Administrations are requested to take up demarcation of HTL and LTL along the CRZ using the general guidelines (issued alongwith the above letter), with the assistance of any one of the following eight authorised agencies viz.,-
