### B 16

(i) The preparation of the CZM Maps is being undertaken jointly by ORSAC, Bhubaneswar and SAC, Ahmadabad. The final approval is awaited from SAC, Ahmadabad. The status of preparation of map by ORSAC, Bhubaneswar & SAC, Ahmadabad & public consultation necessary for CZM Plan as well as request for one year extension of the existing CZM Plan to the MoEF was intimated to the Committee.

### Action taken:

Director, SAC was requested by Forest & Environment Dept to furnish authenticity certificate in respect of the maps with delineation of Zones and demarcation of HTL and LTL. Now they have requested ORSAC to furnish copies of the maps for the entire coast after which the Scientists of SAC will make another visit to Odisha for conducting ground truthing. Necessary certificate will be furnished thereafter. In the meantime MoEF have extended the period of submission of CZMP by one more year in response to F&E Dept request up to January 2015.

(ii) Project Director, ICZMP intimated to the Committee that ToR for workout ICZM Plan is being communicated to World Bank for approval. He informed to the Committee that during preparation of ICZM Plan, CRZ Maps (1:4000 scales) will be prepared for Hotspot areas along Odisha Coast. This will be helpful for the project proponents to collect such maps without delay as well as will involve lesser cost.

### No action is required since this is submitted for information only.

(iii) Project Director, ICZMP also informed to the Committee that process is being initiated for assigning a cost to the data generated from RCPS (under ICZMP, Odisha) for data sharing. It will be of much helpful for the project proponents and others for data sharing with less cost.

No action is required since this is submitted for information only.

C1. Additional data/ Drawing and Design & document submitted as per 22<sup>nd</sup> OCZMA meeting on 28.04.2014 in respect of Establishment of captive minor port and intake & discharge pipeline at the confluence of Jatadharmohan creek near Paradeep for POSCO India project.

A project proposal for "Establishment of captive minor port and intake & discharge pipeline at the confluence of Jatadharmohan creek near Paradeep for POSCO India project" having material handling capacity of 30.6 MTPA with an area of 150 Ac. within 4004 Ac. of area for integrated steel plant of 12 million tons per year and discharge pipeline at Jatadharmohan was placed before the OCZMA for consideration in its 21<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 17.01.2014.

After detail deliberation on various issues the authority suggested the project proponent to provide following additional information/data for further examination during next meeting;

- I. Beach erosion modelling study.
- II. Macro/ micro benthos study as baseline data for impact analysis during construction and operation phase
- III. Information regarding the impact on Olive Ridley turtle during turtle breeding and mass nesting along Gahirmatha coast.
- IV. It was informed that IMMT, Bhubaneswar carried out Marine Ecology/ Water Quality Study.

  The proponent is to submit the competence of the core group of Scientists involve in such kind of study.
- V. Impact of proposed Break-water on the sediment transport.
- VI. Justification regarding significant variation in Water Quality Monitoring Oata between 2005-06 and April, 2013 report.

Considering the suggestions of the Authority, the project proponent submitted the additional information/data, which was also presented /clarified during the 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting of OCZMA held on 28.04.2014. The members raised several issues including the impact of the project on Olive Ridley Turtle, impact of fall of pipe outlets, Cyclonic impacts on erosion etc. and sought clarification on those issues. Hence, the Authority decided to form a Sub-Committee of following members:

- 1. Principal Chief Conservator of Forest (WL) & Chief Wild Life Warden, Odisha
- II. Project Oirector, ICZMP, Odisha
- III. HOO, Marine Science Oept. Berhampur University
- IV. Member Secretary State Pollution Control Board

The Sub Committee is requested to visit the site and to provide a report on the following issues within 3 weeks.

- Macro / micro benthos study as baseline data for impact analysis during construction and operation phase.
- II. Impact of discharge pipeline to the Jatadharmohan creek
- III. Beach erosion & model study

The sub-committee met on 31.05.2014 and reviewed the documents & information provided by M/s. POSCO-India Limited in connection with the establishment of a minor port near

Jatadharmohan. The Committee sought for some additional information regarding (i) the outfall location of discharge point of hot water pipeline, (ii) volume of hot water proposed to be discharged, (iii) the temperature of hot water at outfall points etc. which was subsequently provided by the project proponent to the sub-committee. The sub-committee examined the required points critically and submitted a report (Annexure-I) (dt. 23.06.2014) indicating followings suggestions:

### i. Macro/micro benthos --

**Suggestions:** The committee is of the opinion that project proponent may be asked to make necessary provisions for periodic monitoring of the macro/micro benthos community, from fixed locations preferably during three seasons i.e. summer, post monsoon & winter, along the Jatadahari Muhan and at representative locations inside and outside the port operation area.

### ii. Impact of discharge pipeline to the Jatadharmohan creek. -

**Suggestion:** The Sub-Committee recommend that the project proponent may be asked for making necessary provision for monitoring the water quality in the dredge disposal area as well as at the outfall points of hot water discharge including the influence zone as per the outcome of the model study.

### iii. Beach erosion & model study-

**Suggestion:** The committee observed that as per the shoreline changes study carried out by NCSCM, Chennai, the area falls under moderate to severe erosion prone zone. This stretch is also dynamic in nature, so it is suggested by the committee that project proponent should scrupulously follow the beach nourishment plan by utilising the dredge materials during capital and maintenance dredging.

- iv. Olive Ridley turtle Considering the findings of the study by Wild Life Institute of India on the movement of Olive Ridley sea turtle along Odisha coast to track its movement during October 2006 to December 2010. The committee is of the opinion that the turtle use the adjoining sea along the coast of the Odisha, which also include the proposed site. The committee observed that sporadic nesting takes place in the proposed site but more importantly the adjoining coastal water is used by the turtle as congregation ground. In view of this the committee suggest that;
  - The project proponent should use special light which should not reflect into coastal water (the special light manufactured by Philips and used by Dhamara port is recommended).
  - The project proponent should be in good communication with the D.F.O. wildlife Rajnagar Mangrove Division to keep a track of the congregation status of the turtle and if necessary the movement of vessels may be regulated accordingly.

The sub-committee felt that there is no need for undertaking a field visit at this stage and the observations made by the sub-committee may be considered while considering the proposal.

This project attracts the provisions of EIA Notification, 2006 under schedule 7 (e). Since the proposed cargo handling capacity of the port is 30.6 MTPA, it is considered as Category "A" project & requires prior environmental clearance from MoEF, Govt. of India. In this case, MoEF vide their letter dt. 07.01.2014 revalidated Environmental clearance of this project granted on 19.07. 2007 for a period of 5 years with effect from 18.07.2012, subject to stipulation of the specific/additional condition for strict compliance by the project proponent.

OCZMA may discuss the proposal and consider recommending the proposal for grant of CRZ clearance from MoEF, Gol under CRZ Notification, 2011.

C 2. Additional data/ Drawing and Design & document submitted as per 22<sup>nd</sup> OCZMA meeting on 28.04.2014 in respect of Development of Community (fisher folk) amenities at Chilika, Kalijai, District - Puri under ICZM Project, OTDC Ltd., Odisha

A project proposal entitled "Development of Community (fisher folk) Amenities at Chilika, Kalijai, in the district of Puri under ICZM Projects", which is intended to provide livelihood security to the coastal fisher community and the overall development of cultural and social safeguard of the people by enhancing the tourism potential was placed before the OCZMA during 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting on dt. 28.04.2014. Total estimated cost is Rs. 150 lakhs. The project is funded by World Bank, MoEF and Forest & Environment Dept. Govt of Odisha. The developmental activities include public rain shelter, community toilet and floating jetty.

The activity is permissible under the Para 8 (i) CRZ-I (ii) (b) under CRZ Notification, 2011, "Construction of dispensaries, schools, public rain shelters, community toilets, bridges, roads, jetties, water supply, drainage, sewerage which are require for traditional inhabitants living within the biosphere reserves after obtaining approval from concerned CZMA"

The project does not attract Environmental Clearance under EIA Notification, 2006.

The authority deliberated on the project proposal during 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting on Dt. 28.04.2014 and deferred the matter with the opinion that detail drawing and design is lacking in the proposed project. The proponent was suggested to provide the necessary drawing & designs for consideration during the next meeting.

The project proponent has been intimated to submit & present the necessary drawing & design of the proposed project during the 23<sup>rd</sup> meeting of OCZMA on 02.07. 2014.

OCZMA may discuss the proposal and if considered, may grant CRZ clearance under CRZ Notification, 2011.

### D. FRESH PROPOSALS

1. Reconstruction Housing Project at 16 locations in Ganjam district under Odisha Disaster Recovery Project (ODRP) by Odisha State Disaster Management Authority (OSDMA)

Odisha State Disaster Management Authority (OSDMA), Govt. of Odisha has submitted 16 proposals for CRZ clearance on "reconstruction housing project at 16 locations in Ganjam district under Odisha Disaster Recovery Project (ODRP)". In order to recover from the severe damage of cyclone Phailin, Govt. of Odisha and World Bank have taken responsibility for a reconstruction-cum-vulnerability reduction programme by rebuilding the damaged houses including relocation of the community to safer and tenable land. The major social benefit of this project would be fulfilling housing needs of the poor affected household with civic infrastructure and services such as access road, water, sanitation, drainage and street lights. The resilient houses could avoid mortality and injury from disaster and accruing to local community through employment creation. It also ensures safe keeping of essential stocks / items for post disaster usage and povides temporary protection from the monsoon and the summer to the vulnerable communities. The target community which would be benefitted mostly from the project is fisherman community, BPL family and disaster vulnerable family. This project is funded by World Bank & Govt of Odisha.

During the selection of site, the Govt. of Odisha has considered a reconstruction-cum-vulnerability reduction programme that includes rebuilding the damage houses including relocation of community to safer and tenable lands in coastal districts of Ganjam, Puri & Khurda. The project proponent has prepared an estimate of the elevation of proposed site from MSL (Annexure-II). This was compared with the technical study, prepared by Baird & Associates, Canada being engaged by Govt. of Odisha after the Super Cyclone of Odisha, 1999 on storm surge & flood protection in the state during 2000 (Annexure-III &IV). The numerical storm surge model of IIT, Delhi was used by them to compute storm surge along the Odisha coast. The combined Surge, Tide & Wave set-up indicated in the above study was 4.3m above MSL, which was much less compared to the elevation of the proposed sites for reconstruction housing project at 16 locations along Ganjam coast. This study may be an indication that the location of the above sites may remain beyond the proposed delineation of Hazard Line by Survey of India.

The project has considered the target group as per the eligibility criteria and the beneficiary identification process for the owner driven housing construction, where the design and construction technology (rain water harvesting & green technologies etc. where ever possible) approved by experts agencies in the field of construction technologies under the policy guidelines framed for post cyclone Phailin resilient housing of Govt. of Odisha.

The construction will be under taken as per the ToR for Owner Driven Construction of House (ODCH) under Odisha Disaster Recovery Project (ODRP) to reduce the vulnerability of constructing pucca house was developed by Odisha State Disaster Management Authority (OSDMA) for implementation with the support of district administration. The Multi-disaster resistant permanent houses are to be constructed within 1000 sq ft plot area with a plinth area of 252 sq ft. This shall be a pucca house able to withstand hazards like floods and cyclones. To ensure hazard resilience, the plinth of the houses raised above the average annual flood level and a built in loft that serves as shelter during flood events. House will be constructed with a maximum height of 4 m from the ground. Houses should ideally include water storage facilities and a verandah. Implementation of the project will involve only Govt. land. The traditional building skills cultural preference and local building materials and involvement of the beneficiary may be encouraged to enhance beneficiary ownership.

The proposed dwelling units are small structures having 252sq.ft of plinth area and will mostly use the locally available materials for construction. There will be very limited vehicular movement to the area for transporting construction materials. Besides, minimal construction equipments will be utilised during construction phase. Limited number of construction workers will come from the nearby areas. The proposed mitigation measures will ameliorate the limited/ negligible reversible impact during construction phase. However, during operation phase, project proponent will make necessary provision for recycling of solid waste i.e biodegradable in to compost and non degradable waste will be used for local landfill /sold to such garbage collectors. Besides, liquid waste will be collected in sock pits. The project proponent will leverage with other ongoing Central/State Govt. sponsored schemes to provide civic infrastructure & social services like road, street light, and water & sanitation facilities.

The activity is permissible under Para 3 (e) — "Reconstruction, repair works of dwelling units of local communities including fishers in accordance with local town and country planning regulations"

Para 8 (I) (ii) (b)- "Construction of dispensaries, schools, public rain shelter, community toilets, bridges, roads, jetties, water supply, drainage, sewerage which are required for traditional inhabitants living within the biosphere reserves after obtaining approval from concerned CZMA".

Para 8 (III) A (ii)- "no construction shall be permitted within NDZ except for repairs or reconstruction of existing authorized structure not exceeding existing floor space index ,existing plinth area and existing density and for permissible activities under the notification including facilities essential for activities; Construction/ reconstruction of dwelling units of traditional coastal communities including fisher folk may be permitted between 100 and 200 metres from the HTL along the seafront in accordance with a comprehensive plan prepared by the state Government or the union territory in

consultation with the traditional coastal communities including fisher folk and incorporating the necessary disaster management provision, sanitation and recommended by the concerned state or the union territory CZMA to NCZMA for approval.

Para 8 (III) B (vii): construction or reconstruction of dwelling units so long it is within the ambit of traditional rights and customary uses such as existing fishing villages and goathans. Building permission for such construction or reconstruction will be subject to local town and country planning rules with overall height of construction not exceeding 9 mtr with floors (ground+ one floor)

Para 8 (III) B (viii) Construction of public rain shelters, community toilets, water supply drainage, sewerage, roads and bridges by CZMA who may also permit construction of schools and dispensaries for local inhabitants of the area for those panchayats, the major part of which falls within CRZ if no other area is available for construction of such facilities.

The project does not attract Environmental Clearance under EIA Notification, 2006.

OCZMA may discuss the proposal and if considered, may grant CRZ clearance to the aforesaid 16 projects under CRZ Notification, 2011.

Report of the sub-committee constituted by the OCZMA for review of the proposal for establishment of captive minor port and intake and discharge pipeline at the confluence point of Jatadharmohan creek near Paradeep by POSCO-India Ltd.

A Sub-Committee was constituted in the 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting of Odisha Coastal Zone Management Authority, held on 28.04.2014 to review the proposal for establishment of a captive minor port and intake and discharge pipeline at confluence point of Jatadharmohan with the following members;

- 1. Principal Chief Conservator of Forest(WL) & Chief Wildlife Warden, Odisha
- 2. Project Director, ICZMP and Chief Executive, CDA.
- 3. HOD, Marine Science Department, Berhampur University.
- 4. Member Secretary, State Pollution Control Board, Odisha.

The ToR of the Sub-Committee had been to examine the following issues in connection with the establishment of a minor port by M/s. POSCO India Ltd. at Jatadharmohan and submit a report to be placed in the next meeting of OCZMA.

- Macro/micro benthos study as baseline data for impact analysis during construction and operation phase of the proposed captive port.
- ii. Impact of discharge pipeline to the Jatadharmohan creek.
- iii. Beach erosion & model study.

The Committee met on 31.05.2014 and reviewed the documents &information provided by M/s. POSCO-India Limited in connection with establishment of a minor port near Jatadharmohan. The Committee sought for some additional information regarding (i) the outfall location of discharge point of hot water pipeline, (ii) volume of hot water proposed to be discharged, (iii) the temperature of hot water at outfall points etc. The project proponent provided the additional information which is annexed to this report as Annexure-A. The committee examined the three points critically and followings are the recommendations of the committee.

i. Macro/micro benthos— Macro, micro& meio-benthos are key biological variables and indicator of health of an aquatic eco-system. The proposed site is in estuarine zone, so it is rich in benthic diversity. The benthic communities are mostly sessile and they would not able to move in response to sudden disturbances, which is likely to occur due to the dredging activities during construction as well as during the maintenance dredging and disposal of the dredged spoil.

### Suggestions:

The committee is of the opinion that project proponent maybe asked to make necessary provisions for periodic monitoring of the macro/micro benthos community, from fixed locations preferably during three seasons i.e. Summer, post monsoon & winter, along the Jatadharmohan and at representative locations inside and outside the port operation area.

ii. Impact of discharge pipeline to the Jatadharmohan creek. - As per the additional information provided by the project proponent, they intend to discharge 1.28 lakhs cubic metre hot water per hour into the sea at a distance of 130 mtr. beyond LTL towards the sea within CRZ-IV area. The estimated temperature of hot water discharge would be 36-37 degree as per information provided by the project proponents. As regards the discharge of dredged slurry the project proponents have suggested for construction of retaining pond to collect the dredged water and allow it to stagnate so that they only the water would be allowed to escape out of the retaining pond into the sea through the pipeline.

However, considering the high volume of the dredge slurry likely to be generated during capital dredging, there is every possibility of escape of the slurry from retention pond which would increase the turbidity level in the area where the dredge spoil is proposed to be discharged. Looking at the volume of dredging, the retaining pond proposed as a mitigation measure may not able to hold the high volume dredge slurry.

### Suggestion:

The Sub-Committee recommend that the project proponent may be asked for making necessary provision for monitoring the water quality in the dredge disposal area as well as at the outfall points of hot water discharge including the influence zone as per the outcome of the model study.

- iii. **Beach erosion & model study** The South break water proposed to be constructed to prevent siltation of navigational channel would lead to accretion on the southern bank and would cause erosion on the northern part. The project proponent have suggested sediment bypass to nourish the northern beach which is likely to be eroded due to the southern break water. In addition to this, they are also proposing revetments along the northern shoreline for its stabilisation. The following mitigation measures are proposed by the project proponent.
  - a) Out of 18 million cum of dredged material, 4 million cum would be used for shoreline protection by way of beach nourishment.
  - b) Beach nourishment would be carried out by way of sand by-pass system which would be established at the south side of the southern break water by installing 18 inch pipeline with pumping facility.
  - c) The dredged sand material obtained during maintenance dredging would be used for nourishment of the northern shoreline. It is estimated by them that

about 3 million cum of dredged sand would be available for nourishment of northern shoreline for an approximate length of 5.5 km.

### Suggestions:

The committee observed that as per the shoreline changes study carried out by NCSCM, Chennai, the area falls under moderate to severe erosion prone zone. This stretch is also dynamic in nature, so it is suggested by the committee that project proponent should scrupulously follow the beach nourishment plan by utilising the dredge materials during capital and maintenance dredging.

- iv. Olive Ridley turtle The PCCF( WL) brought to the notice of the sub-committee, a study by Wildlife Institute of India on the movement of Olive Ridley sea turtles along Odisha coast carried out by WI during October,2006 to December,2010, to track the movement of the Olive Ridley, Wildlife Institute of India had mounted 30 nos. PTT transmitters on 30 female Olive Ridley turtles during March, 2007 and on 32 turtles (6 male and 26 female) during January, 2009 at Gahirmatha, Debi mouth and at Rushikulya. Based on their observation for 4 years it is found that;
  - a) Both females and males swam more or less continuously, occupied oceanic waters and displayed no fidelity to any particular area.
  - b) Both the male and female Oliver Ridley turtles undertake open ocean migration in Bay of Bengal from the Odisha coast.
  - c) Preliminary analysis on movements of PTT fixed turtles revealed that the Odisha coast is being used by single population of Olive Ridley sea turtles.
  - d) Many turtles migrated all along the east coast of India at a distance of 200 to 400 km from the shoreline.


The committee also perused three maps; Map-A-Migration path of male and female Olive Ridley turtles in the Bay of Bengal during 2009 and 2010.Map-B-Movement pattern, Dispersal & Migration Path of all tagged Olive Ridley Turtles in the year of 2009 in the Bay of Bengal. Map-C-Movement pattern, Dispersal & Migration Path of all tagged Olive Ridley Turtle in the year 2009 & 2010 in the Bay of Bengal. (Map A, B & C are Annexed to the report).

Considering the findings of the study, the committee is of the opinion that the turtle use the adjoining sea along the coast of the Odisha which also include the proposed site of construction. The committee observed that sporadic nesting takes place in the proposed site but more importantly the adjoining coastal water is used by the turtle as congregation ground. In view of this the committee suggest that;


- 1. The project proponent should use special light which should not reflect into coastal water (the special light manufactured by Philips and used by Dhamara port is recommended).
- 2. The project proponent should be in good communication with the D.F.O. wildlife Rajnagar Mangrove Division to keep a track of the congregation status of the turtle and if necessary the movement of vessels may be regulated accordingly.

The committee felt that there is no need of field visit at this stage and the observations made by the committee may be considered while processing the proposal.


Map-A- Migration path of male and female Olive Ridley turtles in the Bay of Bengal during 2009 and 2010

### Technical study on embankments by Baird and Associates, Canada (2000)



- After the super cyclone of 1999, Baird and Associates, Canada was engaged by the Government of Odisha for a study on storm surge and flood protection in the state.
- They collected historical data of cyclones on Orissa coast from the year 1804 to the year 2000 and carried out storm frequency analysis.
- The numerical storm surge model of IIT (Delhi) was used by them to compute storm surges along the Orissa coast.
- The lowest value of 50 year return period surge was projected as R.L. 3.0m in the southern part of Orissa and the highest was RL. 8.0 m on the Northern part of Orissa.
- From the data of tidal levels for a period of thirty years (1970 to 2000) the 50% exceedence value of high tide level at four locations in Orissa coast were determined.

Water levels at different locations along the coast were projected by adding the 50 year return period cyclone surge, 50% exceedence high tide level and assumed wave set up of 0.5m.

E. Transfer of CRZ clearanced project proposal "Establishment of Swosti SPA and Villa-a-Beach Resort" at Odiya Alapur, Ganjam District of Swosti Vacations Club, Bhubaneswar to Swosti Premium Ltd., Bhubaneswar with a change of name to Swosti Chilika Resort.

CRZ clearance was issued to Swosti Vacations Club, Bhubaneswar for "Establishment of Swosti Spa and Villa-a-Beach Resort in Odiya Alapur, Pathara, Ganjam district" (vide OCZMA Order No. 50 Dt. 03.05.2013), Swosti Premium wrongly (Dt. 20.06.2014) requested OCZMA to transfer the project name to "Swosti Chilika Resort" under hostel Swosti Premium Ltd.

However, Mr. J.K. Mohanty, Managing Director of both the organisations (Swosti Vacations Club, Bhubaneswar and Swosti Premium Ltd, Bhubaneswar) clarified their stand and submitted the request (Dt. 27.06.2014) as the Managing Director of Swosti Vacations Club, Bhubaneswar to transfer the CRZ cleared project "Establishment of Swosti Spa and Villa-a-Beach Resort in Odiya Alapur to the Swosti Premium Ltd., Bhubaneswar" with a change of the name of the project to "Swosti Chilika Resort".
